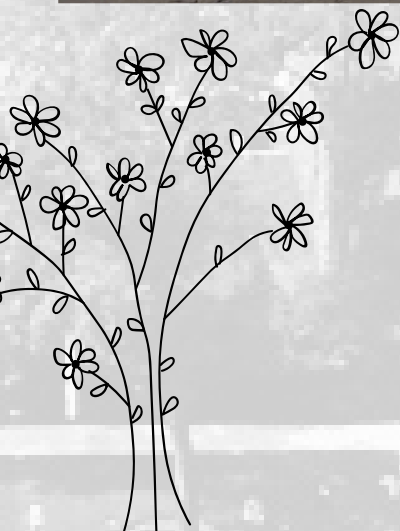

In this week's parsha, we are told that Aharon is to be chosen as the high priest. The pasuk tells us "You shall bring forward your brother Aaron, with his sons, from among the Israelites, to serve Me as priest..." This pasuk indicates to us two important factors that contributed to the leadership of Aharon. On the one hand, it was his relationship to Moshe and his proximity to the highest spiritual levels. On the other, he was from among the Jewish people, and was able to relate to each and every Jew on a deeply personal level. This the paradigm of leadership, and Jewish leadership in particular. While we should always be striving and growing in our relationship-building with Hashem, we can also never ignore or forget people who are still in their beginning stages, and ensure that all of the Jewish people feel connected and loved by one another.
